Port Angeles, Wash. – The Port Angeles High School (PAHS) College & Career Fair is set this year for Tuesday, September 26 between 8:00 – 9:35 a.m. in the Activities Gym. Over 55 institutions will be in attendance to provide information about post-secondary education options.

The College Fair reflects the many pathways which PAHS students pursue after graduation, including two-year colleges, four-year private colleges, four-year public colleges, and career and technical schools, as well as military branches. Representatives will be available to talk about Community-based Employers/Apprentice programs, On-The-Job training programs, and college/financial aid.

In an effort to make this event as meaningful as possible for all participants, some significant changes have been made this year. The student body will be divided into two groups; Freshmen and Sophomores will begin in the Auditorium to listen to three short presentations, then proceed to the Activities Gym to interact with College and Career Representatives. Juniors and Seniors will begin in the Activities Gym, then proceed to the Auditorium for the second half of their allotted time.
