

Frequently Asked Questions....

Who is eligible to enroll in High School 101 classes?

Current eighth-grade students who are not at their current grade level based on district and/or state assessments in English/Language Arts and/or Mathematics.

Is there a cost?

There is **NO COST** to the student/family.

Will students obtain HS credit for participating?

Students will enter high school with .50 elective credit upon successful completion of the course. The course is graded as a Pass or Fail.

Attendance is mandatory.

Is there transportation?

Transportation is provided along two bus routes. Routes will be published and sent home with students.

Is food provided?

Lunch will be provided at noon, **free of charge.**

What is the attendance policy?

Attendance is critical to your student's success. Multiple absences may result in no credit received for the Intro to High School course and/or withdrawal from the program.

High School Success Skills

Instruction will focus on preparation for high school and practicing the keys to becoming a successful student. The curriculum is designed to increase student awareness of goals, high school and beyond plans, college, and career readiness and high school requirements. Integrated Block classes will include skill development in English Language Arts and Science through various themes and projects.

Project Based Learning

Students will participate in theme based projects through their science and ELA course work. Field trips will be included in the program.

English Language Arts

Literary instruction will focus on applying story elements (points of view, character, protagonist, conflict and theme) to short texts and a novel with the intention of promoting high levels of student discussion. Students will also create a writing piece based on a self-selected text with the purpose of analyzing story elements and applying concepts independently. Students will be asked to read and keep a daily log.

Science Students will actively engage in the practice of science, including conducting investigations, sharing ideas with peers, specialized ways of talking and writing, mechanical, mathematical, and computer-based modeling to make sense of data.
